**Local Charleston Holocaust Survivors Speak Out in  
REMEMBER at the Charleston International Film Festival**

**What: REMEMBER Screening at the Charleston International Film Festival**

Charleston, SC – It has been nearly seventy years since the beginning of the Holocaust and today the stories of survivors continue to be told. The documentary *REMEMBER* delivers personal, insider accounts of what we now know to be one of the most terrible atrocities of this modern age.

“The intimate setting of the film enables viewers to feel as though they are having a conversation with an old friend,” says Lara Leroy, *REMEMBER* Producer. “It is an excellent depiction of the horrors of the Holocaust without being gruesome or biased.”

Local artist and PDA Creative Director Kevin Harrison directed and edited the film. “It was a humbling experience being in the presence of the survivors Pincus, Joe and Dientje, said Harrison. Through hearing their stories, my hope is that the viewer will remember that they did not live in a black and white world. The skies were just as blue as they are today.”

Harrison and Leroy along with Associate Producer and Camera Operator Victoria Mele researched the Holocaust, conducted many interviews and compiled original photos. The film connects the experiences of survivors who hold crystallized memories of the horrors of the Holocaust to those of us who might consider it ancient history.

The Charleston International Film Festival offers a collection of documentaries, dramas, comedies and animations from the US and abroad. All screenings take place at the Terrace Theatre, Charleston’s only connection to art house films.
